Did you know?

City of Atlantic Beach Statistics:

- The formal boundaries for the City of Atlantic Beach encompass a land area of 3.49 sq. miles and a water area of 9.48 sq. miles.
- Total population: 13,398
- Male Share of the population: 50.6%
- Female Share of the population: 49.4%
- Senior Citizens: 22.5%
- Median Age of the Population 48

Bike Theft Prevention:

- The Jacksonville Beach Police Department introduced the Bicycle DNA registration program that links bicycles to owners and help Jacksonville Beach Police Department and other law enforcement agencies prevent bike theft.
- Bicycle DNA stickers have tiny microdots embedded that will allow law enforcement to identify the owner of the registered bicycle even if the sticker is removed.
- You can visit your local bike shop to register your bicycle with law enforcement.

The Board approached COAB for the process to apply for speed bumps (now called traffic calming devices). An official traffic study was performed in October on Parkside Drive. Unfortunately, Selva Lakes does not meet over 40% of the criteria.
