POOL HOURS Dawn to Dusk

The Pool Area Closes at Dusk

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY ---- ALL RESIDENTS & GUESTS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK

1. One pool key will be distributed to each unit owner or tenant. Residents must use their own key in order to enter the pool area. **Climbing over the gate or fence will result in loss of pool privileges!** Tenants will be charged a non-refundable \$50 fee for a pool key if the owner did not provide one to them.
2. The gate at the pool entrance and the ladies and men's restroom must be kept closed and locked at all times.
3. Please use the poolside shower before entering the pool. Do not use soap.
4. Guest must be accompanied by a member of a regular household of a Selva Lakes resident.
5. **Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied either by an adult or a person who is at least 16 years of age; otherwise they must leave the pool area.**
6. Running, diving, roughhousing, stone throwing, skateboarding, rollerblading, are not permitted in the pool or pool area. Keep the noise level to a minimum, please. Foul language is unacceptable.
7. Do not use any pool safety equipment, including life preservers or shepherd's crooks, except for emergencies. The Association is required by law to keep life preservers and shepherd's crooks on hand in the event of an emergency.
8. **Children in diapers must wear snug, tight-fitting lycra "swim diapers" or rubber pants. Disposable diapers are not allowed as they can disintegrate and damage the pool filtering system and drain.**
9. **Glass or breakable containers are not allowed in the pool area.** All beverages must be in aluminum, plastic or paper containers. A trash receptacle is provided for all trash.

10. Grills are not permitted in the pool area.
11. Animals are never permitted in the pool area.
12. Bathing suits must be worn in the pool. No cutoffs or street clothing are permitted. Proper bathing attire should be selected for the pool area. Please remember this is a family facility.
13. Person who have a skin infection or are wearing a bandage are not allowed in the pool.
14. Turn off the restroom lights, cabana lights, ceiling fans, and ceiling fan lights when you are last to leave the pool area in the evening.
15. Please use discretion and good judgment when using any pool toy including floats or tubes. Auto or truck inner tubes are not permitted.
16. **Clean up your mess before leaving.** This is your community pool. Please do not deposit cigarette butts in the grass or landscaped areas. Use the plastic ashtrays provided for your convenience.

Ours is such an attractive facility maintained for the enjoyment of all residents. It is incumbent upon each of us to ensure adherence to these rules. Consideration and cooperation by all are keys to a successful and enjoyable pool season.
